It was the evening the team arrived in Nuevo Laredo when Miss Dot said “Brother Glen, I have no idea what I am here for. All I know is that when I was a young girl God prompted me to go on missions and though I wanted to, I didn’t go. Life got busy and soon I had a family, a business, tons of responsibilities and no time to go on missions. Four months ago my husband died and left me with no more excuses. I am 79 years old and I can’t do much, but I know God told me to go. So hear I am.” I hugged Miss Dot assuring her God had a divine appointment for her here and I couldn’t wait to see Him use her.

The next day was Sunday, and we joined my dentist Tlalolini in a weekly ministry passing out food and medicine to the very poor folks. We entered an elderly woman’s home, who lived alone. Her children had all moved away and she had not heard from her two sons in several years. To say the least this old woman had nothing and no one, she was poor in every way. But on that day God had sent one that could understand and Miss Dot was ready. She hugged this old woman like she had loved her all her life. Miss Dot hugged this woman like Jesus would have hugged her. Believe me when I tell you every person in that little, dirt floor one room shack felt the love of Jesus as He entered our presence. Through little 79 year old Miss Dot, Jesus administered divine love to a needy soul.

Since then Miss Dot has been on dozens of mission trips and to at least four other countries. She goes and Jesus shows up and lives in her. I had the privilege of going to Ghana, Africa with Miss Dot this past May. I had the blessing of watching God use her in the African mothers and their little baby’s lives in every village. But on this trip, God sent her 8000 miles to minister to a lady and her daughter that lived right in her own town. She led her roommates to understand the need in their own lives and settle their salvation once and for all.

Yeah sometimes your own town is a long way from home. Thank God for the command and promise of Jesus, that if we go He will come. Please be in Prayer for Miss Dot she is struggling with some circulation issues in her legs. She feels she has been sidelined, but she has already informed the devil she is going on mission with Jesus to Zacatecas in October. I believe Miss Dot will once again see Jesus use her.
