
As we witnessed in two very small and specifically chosen neighborhoods, we saw God using the team to begin the process of making disciples. As well, we were allowed to see how He has grown the ministry of “Creiendo lo Imposible” Baptist church and Pastor Rodolfo Gomez. While evangelizing door to door we met a Christian family. The mother shared her testimony with us. Her name was Isabel, and three years earlier her youngest daughter came home and announced, “I am Christian! Today at the Bible school I prayed and made Jesus my Lord!” The family was surprised and scolded her for not remembering she is Catholic, but she ignored them and went on her way. Later that same day, she was tragically struck and killed by a speeding car. At first the family was angry with the Christians. As the hard days came, the Catholic Church never called or came to see us, yet, even as they screamed, “Go away!” the local Christians kept on coming and caring for us. Until we finally saw that they really cared and were hurting with us. We began to go to Sunday services with them and I am proud to say the whole family, except one son, is now believers and Jesus is our Lord too. Praise God for letting us see how He is a God who rescues the lost. As well as, a clear view of how God can use any church that is willing to reach out in love.

Senior Pastor of FBC Garfield, Brother Jack Maddox, shared with me how they were experiencing huge growth with-in the church there in North West, Arkansas. He said he was certain of one thing, that their growth was a direct result of having gone on mission and God using that experience to ignite a fire in individual’s lives that have returned and spread it through out the entire Church. I have no doubt that those who were looking for Jesus saw Him and I am living proof you can’t see Jesus and not be changed.

Please continue to pray for the church in Morelos as they continue the process of making disciples of the forty-six who made Jesus their Lord last week. I truly thank all of you who prayed specifically for this team and who continually cover this ministry with prayer. I daily thank the Lord for each of you and I hope you can see through my testimony how He uses your faithful prayer and gifts. Please pray for our sister ministry CrossVision de Mexico this month as they continue the mission to reach the Black Heart area of Mexico.

Many of you have asked if the financial crunch has affected our ministry and I would be less than honest if I said no. But in addition I will tell you our God is faithful and with your help we will continue on until the day of His return. My prayer is that God will choose every person who reads this testimony to go out and share how much hope, peace, love and joy is found in a relationship with Jesus.
