LETTER OF LOVE

Oh to be the instrument that deposits the knowledge of Christ in the life of one spiritually dead. This past week I along with four of God's Mexican missionaries returned to the black heart area of Mexico. We truly went to encourage those on the front lines and to better understand the difficulty of the work with in this dark part of our neighbor's house. While there we were greatly encouraged by the progress of the work in Poza de Gamboa just north of the city of Zacatecas. The church has had so many new members join that they are now putting out so many chairs they hardly have space to walk. They also have developed a second work in a near by village, called San Antonio, that is growing fast as well. They are pooling their monies to complete the children's Sunday school rooms and buy small tables and chairs. It was exciting to see Pastor Miguel and his wife Angelica with looks of joy on their faces.

We then traveled south to the state of Aguascalientes and visited the work in Palo Alto. I want to share with you how this verse of scripture was so real in our visit to this town of some 9000 Catholics. Jesus said in John 14 if we have faith we will do what he has been doing, proclaiming the Gospel. As we entered the home of a young woman, who had asked for prayer because she had been diagnosed with cancer and was facing some radical treatments, the obvious lack of spiritual life overwhelmed the immediate physical needs. Never the less we surrounded her and prayed for her health and impending medical treatment first. Just as we began to pray her father entered the home returning from work. He appeared to be slightly irritated by our presence but did not interfere. Sister Liliana asked if they had a Bible and they said they did but no one understood it so they had never read it. As Abel began to read, out of their Catholic Bible, what God's word say's in 2 Corinthians about why they do not understand every face became fixed on the words. He went on to show them how to receive the spirit of God and know that they can have eternal life. The father, mother, grandfather, grandmother, and the young woman were all listening with great interest. When asked if they were ready to pray and receive they lit up with excitement and even old gram-paw hopped to his feet and came close to his family members. What a beautiful sight to behold as this whole family was prayed to receive salvation.

The work in the black heart is slow and hard but I want you to know this is a white harvest field. It is ripe and the time is now. Please pray for those who are working each week to establish points of light with-in this dark area. Ask the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into the harvest field.
