This verse is a powerful source of motivating encouragement to those who are Christians (followers of Jesus Christ). The little church is growing in every area especially among the youth. I was thrilled to see the youth turn out to help with the VBS and street witnessing teams.

Fifteen year old Dakota from Arkansas and three of the Mexican boys, all around Dakota’s age, were on my street witnessing team. The Mexican boys wanted nothing to do with it until I started to challenge them that this fifteen year old gringo was showing them up. One by one they began to join in and with in a couple of houses they had completely taken over the cube and c.d. player. At one of the houses we found four mothers living together, all of their husbands had abandon them and their children. While the youth were sharing the cube inside the house, two older teenaged boys walked up, sat down in a car out front, and started smoking cigarettes. I spoke to them and got their names, Ivon and Christian. It was obvious they really did not want to talk to this tall handsome gringo, so I backed off. But when the boys were through in the house they came out and made a B-line for the car. They ask Ivon if he wanted to listen and he replied sure but only if we can put it in the car c.d. player. They listened but did not respond to the invitation to pray. This gave me a great opportunity to use my God Spanish? I explain in detail what they just heard and made sure they understood the c.d. I ended up being able to lead them in a sinner’s prayer to receive salvation.

God was truly at work in Morelos and the neighboring towns, as a result we saw more than 60 professions of faith and started three Bibles studies in homes, that's not counting children who heard the Gospel at the VBS.

I hope you are looking for where God is at work around you today. If you are not I want encourage you, God wants you to truly understand His abundant life. Seek where He is at work and begin today doing what Jesus does. Please join me in praying for Rodolfo (Fitto) Gomez and Creyendo Lo Imposible Baptist Church in Morelos, MX. They have been working so hard to reach the lost in their area and see them become a community of disciples.
