Most Christians never venture outside of their home towns or even stop to ponder the great gift of their birth place. Often when God sends me into new places I am amazed at how satisfied with life the people are. Many times, like last week, the people have only beans and tortillas to eat. To give a guest eggs or better yet a bowl of chicken soup is to make a tremendous sacrifice. Don't misunderstand me when I say sacrifice. I mean a sacrifice of something else they will need not merely a sacrifice of something they want.

During the last couple of weeks, as I traveled with a team from PIB in Nuevo Laredo to Western Chihuahua and then to Vera Cruz, I was reminded of how different people not born in the United States are. While at the same time realizing how very similar mission teams are. My Mexican brothers and sisters seem to have no judgments or hang-ups about others or themselves. While ministering in a Totonaca Indian community one sister cut hair for ten hours straight and I never heard a negative comment toward the very different people living there. However, during the course of the week the lack of spiritual preparation and Christ-like leadership became more and more evident. God gave me a clear message that our brothers across the border need leadership training and spiritual preparation as much as we do.

One great writer wrote, “Those who suffer together grow stronger and more useable while he who knows only comfort finds he is never ready.” It is too long of a story to get in to now but I can tell you this if you are going to have an accident and total out your ride in a foreign country it is so much better when you have ten other Christians with you. Especially when they are from that country. This month God has truly allowed me to build some awesome relationships with our Christian family living in Mexico. I believe the Lord is building a team of Mexican Missionaries who can travel to Latin American countries and using their Spanish language be much more effective than English speakers. I hope to cast this vision to you in the coming months. I must say a personal Thanks to you who pray for me and the ministry of CrossVision. Your prayers of protection were never so evident nor answered more clearly than during this experience. Most of all Thank God! For He holds the whole world in his hands.
